MCC CAMPUS SAFETY

GOAL: A Safe Campus Environment

The Department of Public Safety is located in the Facilities Building and is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The department patrols campus buildings, parking lots, ramps, and all other college grounds. Patrols are conducted by officers on foot, in motor vehicles, and on bicycles. The patrols are supplemented by closed circuit television cameras located throughout the campus. Patrols of the campus are conducted 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The department maintains police officers, safety officers and student officers on the staff. All officers assist with the many service functions of the department and the prevention of crime through patrols and camera surveillance. The supervisors are certified police officers and have primary responsibility for arrests and criminal investigations on campus when a situation calls for such action.

If you witness a crime, suspicious person, or suspicious incident, contact the Public Safety Department at once. Your awareness and input are essential to campus crime prevention.

If an incident occurs off campus, the department will assist you in contacting the appropriate agency.

The department prepares written reports for all criminal incidents, as well as written reports for vehicle and personal accidents. All reports are strictly confidential. Copies of incident reports, for insurance purposes, may be obtained from the Public Safety Department.

SAFETY TIPS -

The Department of Public Safety offers the following safety tips:

Always let someone know where you are and an approximate time when you will be finished.

Keep your purse in a locked cabinet or locker. Never place your valuables in a highly visible area.

Keep your personal belongings in view at all times. Never leave them, even for a moment, to use the restroom or get a drink.

Do not leave valuables visible in your car. Lock valuables in the trunk.

SAFETY TIPS (Cont.)

If you observe a suspicious person, report it to the Department of Public Safety.

Learn the locations of the blue light emergency telephones on campus.

Never prop open doors, especially fire doors.

Know the location of the Department of Public Safety. The main department is located in the Facilities Building and currently there are four Police Mini Stations on campus. There is a mini station in Lot G (3rd Level of Ramp), MMB (1st Floor), Emergency Response Office, CM 1150 (1st Floor), and the College Prah Center (1st Floor).

3P—Campaign.. Prevent, Protect & Prosecute

MCC is committed to assuring that students are able to complete their studies in a safe environment—whether on campus or off-campus. In 2004, the college in collaboration with the University of Michigan-Flint received a grant from the Department of Justice to initiate the “3P Campaign”- Prevent, Protect and Prosecute Violence Against Women.
