Getting to Know the MCC Department of Public Safety

The Department of Public Safety is responsible for safety, security and emergency response at MCC. The department is located in the Facilities Building and is open 24 hours a day 7 days a week. There are currently five Police Mini Stations on Main Campus; Lot G, Mott Memorial Building (1st floor) Prah! College Center (1st floor) and the Emergency Response office in the Ballenger Field House. The department maintains certified police officers, safety officers and student officers on staff. All officers assist with many service functions of the department and the prevention of crime through patrols and camera surveillance. The supervisors are certified police officers and have primary responsibility for arrest and criminal investigations on campus when a situation calls for such action. The Public Safety Department utilizes the "community policing" philosophy, which is a proactive approach instead of reactive.
