Books at Your Fingertips

Did you know that Mott College Library has over 100,000 items in its collection and our patrons now have access to the collections of 100 other libraries in Michigan? With millions of titles to choose from, the chance of NOT finding what you need is remarkably slim.

- ◆ Materials are shipped and received several times a week through the state-wide delivery service. You will be contacted when your items arrive.

Connecting From Off-Campus

If you are connecting from off campus for an online database, MeLCat, or MeL eBooks, you will be prompted to enter the 14 digit number from the front of your Mott ID card.

Criminal Justice Periodicals

This is a great source for information on law enforcement, corrections, forensic science and homeland security issues. The database includes abstracting and indexing from over 230 magazines and journals, with more than 75 of them available in full-text.

2007 MeL eBook Collection

Mott Library has offered its digital, online book collection, "MeL eBooks," since the year 2000. The collection has grown to over 14,700 books offering titles in academic subject areas including social sciences, humanities, science, technology, medicine, and the arts. The 2007 update consists of 230 recently published books for academic libraries.
