RESEARCH YOUR RELATIVES

The Mott Library subscribes to Heritage Quest Online, a web based genealogy resource. This research tool gives scholars and genealogists access to an extensive array of unique genealogy tools which will be useful for both family and historical research. Included are the Federal censuses from 1790 to 1930, over 25,000 family and local histories, Freedman's Bank and Revolutionary War

records. There are a number of other collections that should prove invaluable to both genealogists and history students. The database is easy to navigate and the collections are regularly updated.

Did you know that the Mott College Library has over 100,000 items in its collection and our patrons now have access to the collections of over 100 other libraries in Michigan? With millions of titles to choose from, the chance of not finding what you need is remarkably slim. We've been a member of the MeLCat

(Michigan Electronic Catalog) cooperative network since January 2007 and the feedback received so far from students, faculty and staff has been overwhelmingly positive. Materials are shipped and received daily through the state-wide delivery service and the demand for library materials (and interest in reading, we

hope) continues to rise. Check it out!

BREAKING THE CODE

Connecting to the Mott College Library from off-campus is easy. Log into www.library.mcc.edu. Finding the 14 digit to access *Online Resources*, login into "My Account" or request an item from *MeL-Cat*, can be tricky.

Breaking the CODE: Use the **Mott College ID barcode 14 digit number** located on the **front** of the ID.

FYI: The access number is **NOT** the 7 digit student number.
