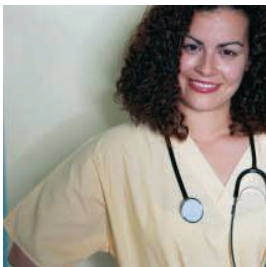

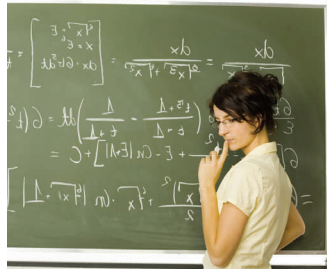
Graduation 2009

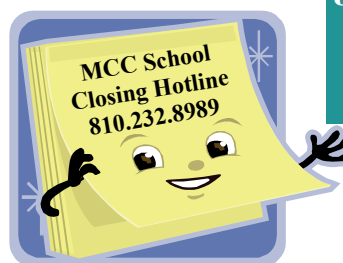
